Costume Basics:

ALL Girls will need to have the following items for the show:

1. At least **2 pairs Nude Footed Skating Tights - Not over-the-boot!**
2. **Black spandex short shorts** to wear under most every costume.

Intermediate and Senior girls will also need:

3. **Undergarments that work with strappy dresses.** Usually a Dance Bra with clear straps works best. Or a Nude Body suit. Or petals.

ALL Boys need black skating pants.
